MH suggested mixing teams up as this has benefited himself and possibly provider mentoring as suggested by Aideen at Southdown's.                      KH suggested a theme approach for people to discuss a particular topic i.e. challenging behaviour and finding a 'hook' for people to discuss more topics from them and include care management, providers and for the themes to focus on specific outcomes.                      Themes suggested: Challenging behaviour, Autism, Dementia, Older People, Complex mental health needs, transitions, forensic mental health, substance misuse, people with LD who are parents, people with mild LD, epilepsy.
